## REGIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY MONUMENT

### A MONUMENT TO PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS

The Regional Public Safety Monument (RPSM) is to honor all branches public safety personnel that have made the ultimate sacrifice protecting the life and property of the people in New Mexico. These community heroes will be honored by the placement of a Memorial Plaque on the Monument Wall.

### WAYS TO SUPPORT THE FALLEN OFFICERS AND PERSONNEL

Past and present municipal, county, state, federal, and tribal law enforcement, fire, EMS, corrections, investigative, paid and volunteer and reserve personnel with five (5) years of honorable service may have a commemorative brick placed on the wall through a donation made in their name. Money raised will be used for improvements to the RPSM including the installation of Memorial Plaques and Trees and Commemorative Bricks and Benches.

#### Commemorative Brick

Inscribed bricks will line the walls of the Monument. The Bricks are limited to three lines, including name, rank and agency. Brick sponsorship is \$35 for individual and \$100 for organization/agency.

#### Commemorative Benches

Several benches will be available for visitors to sit and reflect. Bench sponsorship is \$1,000 and includes a plaque that will be displayed on the bench.

#### Commemorative Trees

Commemorative trees will be planted throughout the Monument. Sponsorship is \$450 and includes a plaque that will be displayed at the base of each tree.

### THE MONUMENT DESIGN

The Memorial was designed by Sites Southwest Landscape Architects and is located off of Southern Blvd. on Pinetree Rd. between the Esther Bone Memorial Library and the United State Post Office. The Public Safety Monument is designed compliment the concept and architecture of the adjacent Veteran's Monument; using the same blocks and color for the memorial walls.

### A CALL TO ACTION

To support the memorial fund is to stand with public safety officers, who risk their lives every day to keep our families and communities safe and secure; it is to declare that these lives were not lost without purpose, that these names will never be forgotten; and it is to honor the surviving families who carried the burdens of their service and the weight of their ultimate sacrifice

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## REGIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY MONUMENT APPLICATION FOR COMMEMORATIVE BRICKS, TREES, BENCHES

Each 4" x 8" commemorative brick will contain the public safety officer's name and department initials (NO EXCEPTIONS). You will then have 3 lines for your inscription, 15 characters per line, one letter per box including spaces and punctuation.

Line 1 – First name and middle initial (if desired) of individual serving/having served  
Line 2 – Last name and suffix (such as Sr., Jr., III if desired)  
Line 3 – Agency initials
